Dear Parents,

Welcome back everyone. We hope you have had a lovely Easter.

Our School Week

Our school week will be a little different until the end of the school year as we do not swim during the summer term. Because of this our PE lessons will continue as normal on a Monday afternoon and we will have an additional session on Friday afternoons. Please make sure that children have their kits in school for these days.

Our Work This Term – Egypt

Maths –To begin the term in maths we will all be continuing to learn about fractions and decimals. After this children in Year 3 will be learning about measurement of time, mass and capacity and the properties of shapes. Children in Year 4 will calculate with money, learn about properties of shape and direction and handle data using statistics

English – Our English work this term will be set around Ancient Egypt. We will be studying different texts set in Ancient Egypt, such as Egyptian Cinderella and Secrets of a Sun King. We will also use the topic to write instructions, explanation and reporting texts.

Science – In Science we will be looking at the topics Plants and Classifying Living Things.

Computing – Our ICT this term will look at different ways of presenting media and how we can use ICT to show data in different ways.

Geography – Our Geography topic will be for some of the second half of the summer term. We will be looking at land use within the UK.

History – Our History topic this term is Ancient Egypt. We will be learning the time line of the different dynasties, famous pharaohs, Egyptian construction, hieroglyphs and Egyptian Gods.

DT/Art – Our topic this term will be Healthy Snacks. We will look at creating healthy sandwiches and at how we can store our sandwiches in a sustainable way. Children will study patterns and design and make their own beeswax wraps to help reduce our use of single use plastic wrap.

PE – This term we will have two school based PE lessons. Children will compete in athletics challenges and improve their striking and fielding skills.

RE – In RE, Class 3 will be learning all about the Hindu religion, including main beliefs, special books and festivals.

Spanish – In Spanish, we will be learning days of the week and family words. As Class 3 did so well reading a story in Spanish last term, after half term we will be focusing on The Enormous Turnip (El Nabo Gigante).
