The school has an annual intake of 8 pupils, with two mixed age classes. Class 1 contains 4-7 year olds and Class 2 7-11 year olds. We currently have 57 pupils on roll, with virtually equal numbers of boys and girls.

The successful candidate will be appointed to the Federation but will be working with children in the West Chinnock KS1 class for 4 days a week – this will be negotiable with the Co-Head Teacher.

There is also a possibility of an additional day (0.2) for the right candidate to take on the role of SENCO across the Federation. If you would be interested in this aspect, please highlight this in your application.

As a voluntary controlled church school, a Christian based ethos is at the heart of all that we do, and is reflected in the school's aims.

The school's catchment area comprises the villages of West and Middle Chinnock however we do take children from outside our catchment area. The pupils at the school come from a wide range of social backgrounds, which is a very positive feature of our intake.

We are very proud of our school and have an excellent reputation across the county for extracurricular activities and sporting success as well as academic achievement.


